Matthew 12

VIOLENCE toward information and animosity toward the sender! The Son of David (12:22, 23; 9:27; 21:9; Isa. 35:5)

- The kingdom of God is invading Satan's domain (12:28)
- Jesus is stronger than Satan (12:29)

12:24, "This [fellow] does not cast out demons except by Beelzebub, the ruler of the demons."

- Dismissive
- Reviles Jesus as demon-possessed
- Insults the Holy Spirit

Réjecting the Word = Réjecting the Sender

- Parable of the Vinedressers Matthew 21:33-39
- The Call out of Darkness –John 12:44-50 –FATHER \rightarrow SON \rightarrow WORD (information)

"And I know that His command is everlasting life. Therefore, whatever I speak, just as the Father has told Me, so I speak." --John 12:50--

Hebrews 12:25-29

25 See that you do not refuse Him who speaks. For if they did not escape who refused Him who spoke on earth, much more *shall we not escape* if we turn away from Him who *speaks* from heaven,

26 whose voice then shook the earth; but now He has promised, saying, "Yet once more I shake not only the earth, but also heaven."

27 Now this, "Yet once more," indicates the removal of those things that are being shaken, as of things that are made, that the things which cannot be shaken may remain.

28 Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear.

29 For our God *is* a consuming fire.

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
